

PUSS IN THE CORNER Premie Quilt

The **Quilt Top** has three different blocks. Cut:

A – 1 Center block – 9” square

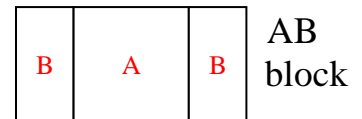
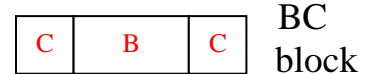
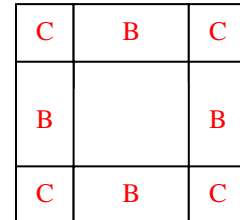
B – 4 Side blocks – 9” x 5¼”

C – 4 Corner blocks - 5¼” x 5¼”

Backing and lightweight **Batting** - 18 ½” square.

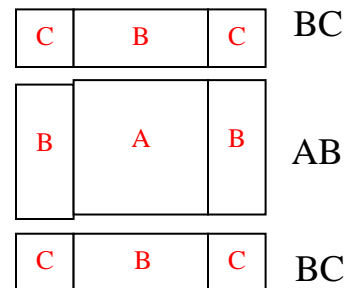
ASSEMBLING THE BLOCKS:

1. Lay out the blocks to look like the quilt.
2. **ALL BLOCKS ARE SEWN USING A ¼’ SEAM.**
Always sew fabric with the **RIGHT SIDES** together.
3. Sew 1 block **C** to one end of Block **B**.
4. Sew another block **C** to the other end of that Block **B**.
5. Press the seams towards block **B**. **This is a BC Block.**
Repeat steps 3, 4, & 5 to make another **BC Block**.
6. Sew 1 block **B** to block **A**. Sew the other **B** block to block **A**. **This is an AB Block.**
7. Press seams towards the B blocks.



ASSEMBLING THE QUILT TOP:

1. Sew 1 **BC** block to the **AC** block, matching seams.
2. Sew the 2nd **BC** block to the **AB** block matching seams.
3. Press seams towards the **BC** blocks. The top is finished.



FINISHING THE QUILT:

1. Lay the **Batting** on table.
2. Place the **Backing** (right side up) on top of batting.
3. Place the **Quilt top** (right side down) on top of backing.
4. Pin the layers together all around the outside of the quilt.
5. Sew around quilt leaving about a 4” opening.
6. Trim seams. Clip corners.
7. Turn the quilt to the right sides. Press.
8. Sew the opening closed by hand or machine stitch.
9. With embroidery thread, tie knots at the four corners where **B** blocks meet or sew along seams.

If desired, sew around the outside edges of the quilt.
